COVID-related Safety and Health Protocols

To help protect all our patients and staff members, please kindly follow these precautions:

A. Prior to entry

- 1. Staff member will perform temperature check
- 2. Anyone with symptoms of COVID-19 will be sent home

B. Face Masks (per City of Pasadena Health Department)

- 1. All our doctors and team members will be wearing facemasks during patient care
- 2. All patients/family members are strongly recommended to wear facemasks when inside the office

C. Patient only without siblings

- 1. 1 parent/guardian for child patient, 1 family member and/or caretaker for individual with special needs, 1 interpreter, etc.
- 2. Please let us know in advance if there are any exceptional needs

D. Other reminders

1. No food or drinks in the office (other than water bottles)

IMPORTANT: If within the **past 5-7 days** you have experienced any symptoms (other than the COVID vaccine reactions), been in close contact with anyone with COVID, please inform our staff immediately.

COVID-related Health Precautions

The safety and health of our patients and staff members is our highest priority.

Therefore, the following precautions are implemented in our office:

A. Social Distancing

- 1. Plexiglass barrier between our front desk staff members
- 2. No-touch payment options (Apple Pay, Samsung Pay, Google Pay)

B. Protective Barrier

- 1. Installed at the front office
- 2. Available as needed on all vision therapy desks

C. Screening for Illness

- 1. Forehead temperature check for all staff and patients upon entry
- 2. Patients or staff with symptoms of illness will be sent home

D. Disinfection (with Clorox/Lysol Wipes, Alcohol ≥ 70%, or Soap/Water)

- 1. Hand washing/Hand sanitizer by all doctors and staff prior to patient care
- 2. Disinfection of all equipment after each patient
- 3. Disinfection of all frames tried on by each patient

E. Face Masks

- 1. All our doctors and team members will be wearing facemasks
- All patients/family members are strongly recommended to wear facemasks per City of Pasadena Health Department when inside the office

F. Air Quality

1. HEPA Air-filter units with UV-disinfection in each room to maximize air quality

G. Vision Therapy Sessions

1. All equipment is disinfected after each patient
